Can I solve word problems? Take a word problems sheet from the homework folder. Remember to use RUCSAC to help you solve the questions!	The word problems are labelled – take the right challenge for you!	Can I write an effective description? Take one of the Hans Christian Anderson scenes from the Homework folder and write a description of the scene.	Mild - use adjectives to describe the scene Hot – make your description appeal to all the senses Spicy – use a variety of sentence openers to make your writing interesting
Can I construct a graph? Once you have measured the height of all the members of your family (above), draw a graph showing this information.	Mild – Take a sheet with the axes labelled Hot - Draw a bar graph Spicy – Draw a line graph comparing the age of each family member with their height	Can I write a story using my imagination? Take one of the Hans Christian Anderson scenes and imagine you are a character there. Write a story about your adventures.	Mild – Include a beginning, middle and end. Hot – Include dialogue (punctuated correctly!) Spicy – Include suspense in your writing.
Can I measure perimeter? Find 5 objects at home that are rectangles or squares (e.g. books, baking trays etc.). Measure the perimeter of each shape.	Mild – Measure in cm Hot - Measure in cm and convert to mm. Spicy – Measure in cm and convert to mm and m.	Can I write a set of instructions? Choose a toy or game that you have at home. Write instructions explaining how to use/play with it.	Mild – Use time connectives to organise your writing Hot – Use imperative (bossy) verbs Spicy – Add an introduction to give a bit more information about your chosen toy or game.
Can I solve addition and subtraction calculations? Make a list of the cost of 10 different toys and use to create 10 different addition and subtraction calculations.	Mild – Add up 2 toys at a time. Hot – Add up 3 toys at a time. Spicy – Work out the change you get when you buy 2 different toys with £50.	Can I complete a review? Write a review after you have finished watching a film, TV show or good book!	You can take a review sheet to help you!
Can I use the 24-hour clock? Create a timetable for your normal school day, from the time you get up to the time you go to bed.	Use the 24-hour clock in all your timings!	Can I use persuasive writing techniques? Choose a toy or a game you have at home. Design a poster advertising it, trying to persuade people to buy it	Mild – Use positive language about the toy Hot - Use rhetorical questions Spicy – Use personal pronouns (directed at the reader) and alliteration
