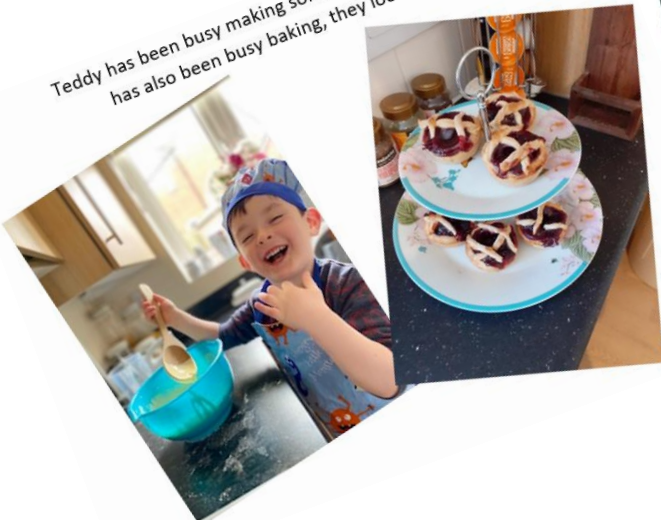
Mrs Chapman has been busy growing rocket in her garden!
